

## Estimated Average Per Pupil Cost for Public Education

*Virginia Code Section 22.1-92 requires each school division to provide notification of its estimated per pupil cost for public education for the coming school year. The Code further mandates that the notification shall include actual per pupil state and local education expenditures for the previous school year. The chart below meets that legal requirement.*
